FATAL MISTAKES YOU MUST AVOID

When Trying To Catch A Cheating Spouse

Here are six mistakes that if you make them, they could prevent you from getting the proof you need and could also get you into serious trouble. A couple of them may seem very obvious. And a couple of them you may say I don't care if this happens to me. Well if you have kids quit being selfish. They need you around. Going to jail can be embarrassing not to mention how it can hurt your case in court.

That's just one bad thing that can happen to you. If your spouse knows you are trying to follow him or her, it just got a hundred times harder to catch them. Secrecy is needed and it will make your job a whole lot easier if your spouse has no idea you are trying to find out what he or she is up to.

I worked a case once where the husband and wife were both doctors. The husband had temporary custody of the two children. The wife wanted custody badly. One night in a fit of rage she drove to his house and attempted to take the kids away on her own. Well after he refused to let them go, she stormed out of the house got into her Mercedes and proceeded to ram his Mercedes numerous times. When the police arrived I don't have to tell you what happened. Not only did she spend a night locked up but the husband had a police report that was going to look pretty good for him in court.

Use good judgment at all times. Easier said than done I know.

1. **Getting Caught**

When gathering your evidence, getting caught by your spouse is one of the worst things that can happen. When going

through their personal items (i.e. cell phone, car, gym bag, don't let them catch you. Be sure your spouse is in the shower or has left the home for awhile. Don't take unnecessary chances. Your spouse will screw up and give you time to check their things if you stay cool. Make sure that you leave yourself plenty of time to put things back in place to ensure you do not get caught going through your partners private things.

2. Leaving Evidence of Your Snooping

Do not leave any evidence that you were snooping through your spouses personal effects. If you go through papers and files make sure you are aware of the order and position of the papers so you can be sure to put them back in the same place you found them, in the same order and in the same position.

Even if you have a messy spouse that tends to scatters their papers in messy piles, he may still be able to recognize that something has been moved from one pile to the other or from the top of the pile to the bottom of the pile, or that the piles are neater than they was originally.

If you make copies of the evidence that you find or record telephone numbers from the cell phone, keep it in a place that he will NEVER look. Remember the things that you find that your spouse has hidden may have been hidden in places that he thought you would never look. It may be a good idea to hide these items somewhere away from your home. Either at your office or at a friend or relative's house that you can trust. 3. Confronting Your Spouse Too Soon

Confronting your spouse about the cheating before you have enough cold hard facts and evidence to nail him or her will only serve to give her a heads up that you are suspicious. This will give your spouse the opportunity to cover their tracks, create alibis and prevent you from ever being able to gather the real evidence you need to prove that they are cheating. 4. Following Your Spouse

Never try to follow your spouse in your car. Leave this to professionals who know how to do it without getting caught. Most spouses that try to follow their spouse end up getting caught. Some smart spouses who discover that their wives or husbands are following them may not even let them know that they know they are being followed. Instead they will lead you on all kind of wild goose chases.

This again, could ruin your chances of getting the solid evidence you need to nail him. Its best that you do not use relatives or friends to try and follow your spouse either. Everyone thinks they are Magnum PI but trying to follow someone in real life is very hard. Red lights and traffic are only a few of the problems you will encounter. Get to close and your spouse is on to what is happening. Trying to follow your spouse, keep your distance, then catch up when your spouse is getting away from you increases the chances of an accident. Especially in the city. Just leave following your spouse alone. There are other ways to catch your spouse cheating.

One thing you may try if all else fails is a spy GPS device that goes on the vehicle. Especially if your spouse has a job that requires a lot of driving. These require that you mount them on the vehicle so again make sure you have time to get the job done. Most have a magnet you can use to mount the device underneath the vehicle.

5. Losing Your Temper

Losing your temper and resorting to violence could land you in jail. It could also result in serious harm to you, your spouse or the other person involved. No matter how hurt, humiliated, betrayed, or angry you feel try to keep your cool.

Remember that the more evidence you get on your spouse the easier it will be to prove in a court of law that your spouse is committing adultery.

Once this is done your spouse will pay the price. Some states even allow husband and wife to sue the “other person” for alienation of affection

if it can be proven that the lover knew that the other person was married and willfully engaged in an affair that interfered with the marriage. All states have different laws so check with an attorney in your state for your states laws.

6. Confronting The Other Person

Most of the time the other person is someone you know. It often is a friend, neighbor, relative or someone you may know from your spouse's job. On my website I talk about keeping your investigation private. To many times when you catch your spouse they are having affair with someone that you never dreamed it would be.

If it's a friend the friendship will most likely be over. Of course if it's a relative the same may be true. Many people feel that they need to forgive the other person later on especially if it's a relative . That is a personal decision.

The bigger problem is using the information for revenge. Also you will probably see the person around town if it was a friend or relative but you cannot afford to let your temper get the best of you. It's not good for you or worth it to make a scene in public.

It's time for you to move on with your life. There is a time and place for everything but having an argument in public is not it. Your true friends and relatives will stick by you and you do not want to put them in an awkward situation by having public arguments with your spouse's lover.

Sometimes people do meet with the other person for different reasons. The other person may have been lied to by your spouse and they are willing to come clean and help you out now. If this happens and you do meet with the other person be sure to bring a friend along for moral support and to help keep your temper in check.

Know exactly what you are going to say, the questions you will ask and what you want to get out of the meeting. The other person is probably expecting you to be very angry and possibly expects you to go off on them. Don't let your anger get the best of you and leave knowing you are a better person. This is also a time to get some crucial information that can help you

out if you are going to file for divorce. I would talk to my attorney first before having the meeting.
